

Section 2: Policies

2.A. Textbooks

In the Diocese of Charlotte, all grade and high school religious education programs in Catholic Schools, Parish Faith Formation Programs and Catholic Home Schools are required to use only textbooks that have been judged to be in conformity with the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* by the Subcommittee on the Catechism of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The list may be found on the USCCB website for the [Conformity Listing of Catechetical Texts and Series](#).

Doctrinal content is best presented in systematic, age-appropriate basal texts rather than supplemental materials alone. Some supplementary materials are not eligible for the review process of the USCCB Subcommittee on the Catechism for a judgment on conformity to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. All supplementary materials must have ecclesiastical approval, preferably an Imprimatur and Nihil Obstat acknowledging that there is nothing contrary to Catholic Teaching.

All Catholic High School Religion and Theology programs in the Diocese are to use the high school *Didache Semester Series* Textbooks published by Midwest Theological Forum.
